Policy on Proxy Voting

- 1. The Constitution provides for proxy voting on any issue at a general meeting.
- 2. The appointed proxy may be the chairperson of the meeting (usually the president) or any other financial member of the Society.
- 3. Proxies may be open proxies or closed proxies
 - 3.1 An open proxy is one by which the holder of the proxy is authorised to vote as the proxy sees fit.
 - 3.2 A closed proxy is one where the holder of the proxy is directed to vote for or against a given proposal.
 - 3.3 A closed proxy may therefore be exercised only in respect of a motion of which notice has been given and which appears on the agenda.
- 4. The appointment of a proxy must be in writing on the approved form.
- 5. In accordance with the Constitution a copy of the completed proxy form must be lodged with the chairperson of the meeting not later than the day preceding the day appointed for the meeting.
- 6. The President, or other appointed chairperson, will collate the proxies.
- 7. At the commencement of the meeting, after apologies have been received, the chairperson will announce details of the number of proxies held, and by whom they are held.
- 7. When a vote is taken votes cast in person at the meeting will be counted first, followed by proxy votes.
